The Organization for Human Brain Mapping, is pleased to announce the Call for Nominations for the Education in Neuroimaging Award. The award will be given to an OHBM member who has made significant contribution to education and training in the field of neuroimaging.

### **Award Criteria**

To be eligible for this award, nominees are required to have made significant contributions to education and training in the field of neuroimaging. **Please note: Current OHBM elected leadership are ineligible to receive OHBM Awards.**

### **Nomination Process**

Nominations may be made by any individual **other than** the nominee, and should include:

1. A short biographical statement/CV in **two pages or less**, on the nominee that includes name, current mailing address, current phone and email, information on advanced professional degrees or specialty degrees geared towards education and training.
2. A Letter of Nomination, **in one thousand words or less**, providing a detailed description of the nominee's unique contributions to education and training in neuroimaging. Use specific examples and data to support your nomination. Note we are looking for a text-based description demonstrating how contributions support education and training and not simply a resume of lifetime achievements or positions held.

### **Review Process**

Nominations will be evaluated with the final selection made by the OHBM Council. The recipient will be notified in February 2018.

### **Award**

The recipient will receive a cash award of \$5,000 USD along with an engraved plaque. Both are presented to the recipient at the 24<sup>th</sup> Annual Meeting being held June 17-21, 2018 in Suntec City, Singapore. Awardee will be given the opportunity to give a brief remark during the Annual Meeting.
