

# ORGANIZATION FOR HUMAN BRAIN MAPPING Young Investigator Award

The Organization for Human Brain Mapping, is pleased to announce the Call for Nominations for the Young Investigator Award in Human Brain Mapping recognizing a young investigator who has made significant contributions to the field of human brain mapping.

Please submit all required nomination information here by November 10, 2017.

#### **Award Criteria:**

- 1. Be under 40 years of age on July 1, 2017
- 2. Be within 10 years of completing postdoctoral fellowship or residency on July 1, 2017
- 3. Have made significant contributions to the field of human brain mapping
- 4. Please note: Current OHBM elected leadership are ineligible to receive OHBM Awards

### **Nomination Process**

Nominations may be made by any individual other than the nominee and should include:

- 1. A brief statement (in 1000 words or less) giving the reasons for nomination and commenting on the nominee's contributions to the field of human brain mapping
- 2. A short biographical statement (**no more than two pages**) on the nominee, including: Name; Date of birth; Present affiliation; Current mailing address; Current phone, fax and email; Advance professional degrees (including institutions and dates); List of postdoctoral fellowships, residencies and professional appointments (including dates of service)
- 3. A short list of \*most notable\* publications (in 300 words or less); URL of website (if available)

## **Review Process**

Nominations will be evaluated with the final selection made by the OHBM Council. The recipient will be notified in January 2018.

#### **Award**

The recipient will receive a cash award of \$5,000 USD along with an engraved plaque. Both are presented to the recipient at the 24<sup>th</sup> Annual Meeting being held June 17-21, 2018 in Suntec City, Singapore. Awardee will be given the opportunity to give a brief remark during the Annual Meeting.
